Every year on the morning of the Pride Parade, Front Runners & Walkers San Diego host the Pride 5K Run/Walk. Funds raised at the San Diego Pride 5K generate significant donations for the charity partners – The San Diego LGBT Community Center and San Diego Pride.

This year, more than ever, these charities needed our support. Mission Fed was proud to serve as the Platinum Sponsor of the reimagined 2020 San Diego Virtual Pride 5K, held virtually in consideration of the health and safety of participants, volunteers, and the community. Over the weekend of July 18 and 19, 75 Mission Fed team members and their friends and families joined 1,300 participants with the goal to raise \$20,000 and promote health and wellness to members of the LGBTQ community. The funds raised will be used by San Diego Pride and The Center to offer free programs and services to the LGBTQ community during these difficult times.

Rediscovered LatinX Cinema Through a Virtual Lens

Since its establishment 27 years ago, the San Diego Latino Film Festival has developed into one of the larger and well-respected Latino film festivals in the world with over 325,000 attendees and over 3,800 screened films from across Latin America and the United States.

Mission Fed looked forward to the virtual relaunch of the 27th San Diego Latino Film Festival held September 17 – 27. The festival was originally planned for March, however, it was postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The 11-day celebration of Latino Cinema, Arts & Culture presented over 100+ films online and included live virtual Q&A sessions with filmmakers, and more.

As a Film Sponsor of this year's event, Mission Fed was proud to present "Our Quinceañera," a documentary film about a high school principal from a small town in Texas who hosts an annual Quinceañera for students who can't afford to throw a celebration of their own. Viewers watching from the convenience of their home also had a unique sneak-peak into our first ever
